A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. HAZARDOUS MATERIAL ENDORSEMENT EX-
- 4 EMPTION.
- 5 (a) Exclusion.—Section 5117(d)(1) of title 49,
- 6 United States Code, is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (B), by striking "and" at
2	the end;
3	(2) in subparagraph (C), by striking the period
4	at the end and inserting "; and"; and
5	(3) by adding at the end the following:
6	"(D) a service vehicle carrying diesel fuel
7	in quantities of 3,785 liters (1,000 gallons) or
8	less that is—
9	"(i) driven by a class A commercial
10	driver's license holder who is a custom har-
11	vester, an agricultural retailer, an agricul-
12	tural business employee, an agricultural
13	cooperative employee, or an agricultural
14	producer; and
15	"(ii) clearly marked with a placard
16	reading 'Diesel Fuel'.''.
17	(b) Exemption.—Section 31315(b) of title 49,
18	United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
19	following:
20	"(8) Hazardous materials endorsement
21	EXEMPTION.—The Secretary shall exempt all class A
22	commercial driver's license holders who are custom
23	harvesters, agricultural retailers, agricultural busi-
24	ness employees, agricultural cooperative employees,
25	or agricultural producers from the requirement to

obtain a hazardous material endorsement under part
383 of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, while
operating a service vehicle carrying diesel fuel in
quantities of 3,785 liters (1,000 gallons) or less if
the tank containing such fuel is clearly marked with
a placard reading 'Diesel Fuel'.".
