- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Axe the Stimulus
- 5 Plaques Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. SIGNAGE.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, none of
- 8 the funds made available under the American Recovery
- 9 and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-5) may
- 10 be used for signage to indicate that a particular project

- 1 is being carried out using funds made available under that
- 2 Act.
