A BILL

To make the National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass available at a discount to members of the Armed Forces and veterans.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Honoring Service
- 5 Through National Park Access Act".

1	SEC. 2. NATIONAL PARKS AND FEDERAL RECREATIONAL
2	LANDS PASS FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED
3	FORCES AND VETERANS.
4	Section 805(b) of division J of the Consolidated Ap-
5	propriations Act, 2005 (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)), is amended
6	by adding at the end the following:
7	"(3) Military discount.—
8	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall
9	make the National Parks and Federal Rec-
10	reational Lands Pass available to any member
11	of the uniformed services or any member of the
12	National Guard or Reserves at a reduced rate
13	equal to 50 percent of the cost of the National
14	Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass to
15	the public established under subsection (a)(5).
16	"(B) Term.—A National Parks and Fed-
17	eral Recreational Lands Pass issued under this
18	paragraph shall be valid for 1 year after the
19	date of issuance of the pass.
20	"(4) Veteran discount.—
21	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall
22	make the National Parks and Federal Rec-
23	reational Lands Pass available, at a cost of
24	\$10, to any veteran who was separated from
25	military service under conditions other than dis-
26	honorable, if the veteran provides proof of that

status by providing a copy of the Certificate of 2 Release or Discharge from Active Duty (De-3 partment of Defense Form DD214) or valid military retiree identification card of the veteran.

> "(B) TERM.—A National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass issued under this paragraph shall be valid for the lifetime of the passholder.".
