- 6 ICAL SUBDIVISIONS.
- 7 (a) In General.—Section 105(j)(2) of the Internal
- 8 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

1	(1) by inserting "or established by or on behalf
2	of a State or political subdivision thereof" after
3	"public retirement system", and
4	(2) by inserting "or 501(c)(9)" after "section
5	115" in subparagraph (B) thereof.
6	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
7	this section shall apply to payments after the date of the
8	enactment of this Act.
