A BILL

For the relief of Hussein Bazzi.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 5 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Hussein Bazzi shall be eligible for 6 7 an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of 8 an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon 9 filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of that Act (8 U.S.C. 1154) or for ad-10 justment of status to lawful permanent resident. 11

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Hussein Bazzi enters the United States before the filing deadline set forth 2 3 in subsection (c), Hussein Bazzi shall be considered to 4 have entered and remained lawfully in the United States 5 and shall be eligible for adjustment to lawful permanent 6 resident status under section 245 of the Immigration and 7 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of the date of the en-8 actment of this Act.

9 (c) APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Sub-10 sections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for 11 issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status 12 are filed with appropriate fees not later than 2 years after 13 the date of the enactment of this Act.

14 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.— 15 Upon granting immigrant visas or lawful permanent resident status to Hussein Bazzi, the Secretary of State shall 16 17 instruct the proper officer to reduce by one, during the current or next following fiscal year, the total number of 18 19 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the 20 country of birth of Hussein Bazzi under section 202(a)(2)21 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 22 1152(a)(2)).
