## A BILL

To provide assistance for workforce investment activities to unique populations in Alaska and Hawaii.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Workforce Investment
- 5 for Unique Populations in Hawaii and Alaska Act of
- 6 2011".
- 7 SEC. 2. ASSISTANCE TO UNIQUE POPULATIONS IN ALASKA
- 8 AND HAWAII.
- 9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 10 sion of law, the Secretary of Labor is authorized to provide

- 1 assistance to the Cook Inlet Tribal Council, Incorporated,
- 2 and the University of Hawaii Maui College, for the unique
- 3 populations who reside in Alaska or Hawaii, respectively,
- 4 to improve job training and other workforce investment
- 5 activities (as defined in section 101 of the Workforce In-
- 6 vestment Act of 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2801 et seq.)).
- 7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
- 8 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
- 9 such sums as may be necessary for each of fiscal year
- 10 2012 and each subsequent fiscal year.
