A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for extended months of Medicare coverage of immunosuppressive drugs for kidney transplant patients and other renal dialysis provisions.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Comprehensive Im-

15	1836(b), the following rules shall apply:
16	"(1) In the case of such an individual who is
17	deemed to have enrolled in part B for coverage of
18	immunosuppressive drugs under section $1837(m)(3)$,
19	such individual's coverage period shall begin on the
20	first day of the month in which the individual first
21	satisfies section 1836(b).
22	"(2) In the case of such an individual who en-
23	rolls in part B for coverage of immunosuppressive
24	drugs under section 1837(m)(2), such individual's
25	coverage period shall begin on the first day of the

1	month in which the individual first satisfies section
2	1836(b) or the month following the month in which
3	the individual so enrolls, whichever is later.
4	"(3) The provisions of subsections (b) and (d)
5	shall apply with respect to an individual described in
6	paragraph (1) or (2).
7	"(4) In addition to the reasons for termination
8	under subsection (b), the coverage period of an indi-
9	vidual described in paragraph (1) or (2) shall end
10	when the individual becomes entitled to benefits
11	under this title under section 226(a), 226(b), or
12	226A.".
13	(B) Conforming amendments.—Section
14	1838(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
15	1395q(b)) is amended, in the matter following

19	(5) Premiums for individuals only eligi-
20	BLE FOR COVERAGE OF IMMUNOSUPPRESSIVE
21	DRUGS.—Section 1839 of the Social Security Act
22	(42 U.S.C. 1395r) is amended—
23	(A) in subsection (b), by adding at the end
24	the following new sentence: "No increase in the
25	premium shall be effected for individuals who

1	are enrolled pursuant to section 1836(b) for	
2	coverage only of immunosuppressive drugs.";	
3	and	
4	(B) by adding at the end the following new	
5	subsection:	
6	"(j) Determination of Premium for Individ-	
7	UALS ONLY ELIGIBLE FOR COVERAGE OF IMMUNO-	
8	SUPPRESSIVE DRUGS.—The Secretary shall, during Sep-	
9	tember of each year, determine and promulgate a monthly	
10	premium rate for the succeeding calendar year for individ-	
11	uals who enroll only for the purpose of coverage of im-	
12	munosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b). Such pre-	
13	mium shall be equal to 35 percent of the monthly actuarial	
14	rate for enrollees age 65 and over, determined according	
15	to paragraph (1), for that succeeding calendar year. The	
16	monthly premium of each individual enrolled for coverage	
17	of immunosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b) for	
18	each month shall be the amount promulgated in this sub-	
19	section. Such amount shall be adjusted in accordance with	
20	subsections (c) and (f).".	
21	(6) GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTION.—Section	
22	1844(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.	
23	1395w(a)) is amended—	
24	(A) in paragraph (3), by striking the pe-	
25	riod at the end and inserting "; plus";

2	paragraph:

- "(4) a Government contribution equal to the estimated aggregate reduction in premiums payable under part B that results from establishing the premium at 35 percent of the actuarial rate under section 1839(j) instead of 50 percent of the actuarial rate for individuals who enroll only for the purpose of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b)."; and

 - "The Government contribution under paragraph (4) shall be treated as premiums payable and deposited for purposes of subparagraphs (A) and (B) of paragraph (1).".
 - (7) EXTENSION OF SECONDARY PAYER REQUIREMENTS FOR ESRD BENEFICIARIES ELIGIBLE
 FOR COVERAGE OF IMMUNOSUPPRESSIVE DRUGS.—
 Section 1862(b)(1)(C) of the Social Security Act (42
 U.S.C. 1395(y)(b)(1)) is amended by adding at the
 end the following new sentence: "With regard to immunosuppressive drugs furnished to an individual
 who enrolls for the purpose of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b) on or after

- January 1, 2012, this subparagraph shall apply without regard to any time limitation, except that when such individual becomes entitled to benefits under this title under sections 226(a) or 226(b), or entitled to or eligible for benefits under this title under section 226A, the provisions of subparagraphs (A) and (B), and the time limitations under this subparagraph, respectively, shall apply.".
 - (8) Ensuring coverage under the medicare savings program.—Section 1905(p)(1)(A) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(p)(1)(A)) is amended by inserting "or an individual who is enrolled under part B for the purpose of coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b)" after "section 1818".
 - (9) PART D.—Section 1860D–1(a)(3)(A) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–101(a)(3)(A)) is amended by inserting "(but not including an individual enrolled solely for coverage of immunosuppressive drugs under section 1836(b))" before the period at the end.

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
