Mr. MANCHIN (for himself, Mr. HOEVEN, Mr. KIRK, and Mr. SCHUMER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Budget

A BILL

To require a jobs score for each spending bill considered
in Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jobs Score Act of
5 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE CBA.**

7 Section 402 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
8 (2 U.S.C. 653) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and”;

1 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period and
2 inserting “; and”; and

3 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(4) an estimate of the number of jobs which
6 would be created, sustained, or lost in carrying out
7 such bill or resolution in the fiscal year in which it
8 is to become effective and in each of the 4 fiscal
9 years following such fiscal year, together with the
10 basis for each such estimate.”.
