SEC. 2. NO REDUCTION IN BASIC ALLOWANCE FOR HOUS ING FOR ARMY NATIONAL GUARD AND AIR
 NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS WHO TRANSI TION BETWEEN ACTIVE DUTY AND FULL TIME NATIONAL GUARD DUTY WITHOUT A
 BREAK IN ACTIVE SERVICE.

7 Section 403(g) of title 37, United States Code, is
8 amended by adding at the end the following new para9 graph:

10 "(6) The rate of basic allowance for housing to be 11 paid a member of the Army National Guard of the United 12 States or the Air National Guard of the United States 13 shall not be reduced upon the transition of the member 14 from active duty to full-time National Guard duty, or from 15 full-time National Guard duty to active duty, when the 16 transition occurs without a break in active service.".
