5	(a) In General.—Section 16131(b)(2) of title 10,
6	United States Code, is amended by striking "equal to"
7	and all that follows and inserting "not less than the per-
8	centage by which—
9	"(A) the average cost of undergraduate tuition
10	in the United States, as determined by the National
11	Center for Education Statistics, for the last aca-
12	demic year preceding the beginning of the fiscal year
13	for which the increase is made, exceeds
14	"(B) the average cost of undergraduate tuition
15	in the United States, as so determined, for the aca-
16	demic year preceding the academic year described in
17	subparagraph (A).".
18	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
19	subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2012, and
20	shall apply to adjustments in amounts of educational as-
21	sistance for members of the Selected Reserve that are
22	made for fiscal years beginning on or after that date
