Mr. Bingaman (for himself and Mr. Udall of New Mexico) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

## A BILL

To adjust the boundary of the Carson National Forest, New Mexico.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Carson National Forest Boundary Adjustment Act of 2011'".

SEC. 2. CARSON NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.
(a) In General.-The boundary of the Carson National Forest in the State of New Mexico is adjusted to incorporate the approximately 4,990 acres of land gen-
erally depicted as "Miranda Canyon Boundary" on the map entitled "Carson National Forest Boundary Adjustment" and dated September 21, 2010.
(b) Land and Water Conservation Fund.-For purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 4601-9), the boundaries of the Carson National Forest, as modified under subsection (a), shall be considered to be the boundaries of the Carson National Forest as in existence on January 1, 1965.
