6 SEC. 2. REPEAL.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The following Acts, and the8 amendments made by such Acts, are repealed:

9 (1) The Patient Protection and Affordable Care
10 Act (Public Law 111–148).

(2) The Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152).

(b) EFFECT OF LAW.—The provisions of law amend ed by the Acts referred to in subsection (a) are restored
 as if such Acts had never been enacted.
