1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "National Guard, Re3 serve, 'Gray Area' Retiree, and Surviving Spouses Space4 available Travel Equity Act of 2011".

5 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF RESERVE MEMBERS, GRAY AREA
6 RETIREES, WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS OF RE7 TIRED MEMBERS, AND DEPENDENTS FOR
8 SPACE-AVAILABLE TRAVEL ON MILITARY AIR9 CRAFT.

10 (a) ELIGIBILITY.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 157 of title 10,
United States Code, is amended by inserting after
section 2641b the following new section:

14 "§ 2641c. Space-available travel on Department of De-

15fense aircraft: reserve members, reserve16members eligible for retired pay but for17age; widows and widowers of retired18members; and dependents

19 "(a) RESERVE MEMBERS.—A member of a reserve
20 component holding a valid Uniformed Services Identifica21 tion and Privilege Card shall be provided transportation
22 on Department of Defense aircraft, on a space-available
23 basis.

24 "(b) RESERVE RETIREES UNDER APPLICABLE ELI25 GIBILITY AGE.—A member or former member of a reserve
26 component who, but for being under the eligibility age ap•\$ 1768 IS

plicable to the member under section 12731 of this title,
 otherwise would be eligible for retired pay under chapter
 1223 of this title shall be provided transportation on De partment of Defense aircraft, on a space-available basis.
 "(c) WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS OF RETIRED MEM BERS.—
 "(1) IN GENERAL.—An unremarried widow or

widower of a member of the armed forces described
in paragraph (2) shall be provided transportation on
Department of Defense aircraft, on a space-available
basis.

12 "(2) MEMBERS COVERED.—A member of the
13 armed forces referred to in paragraph (1) is a mem14 ber who—

15 "(A) is entitled to retired pay;

16 "(B) is described in subsection (b);

17 "(C) dies in the line of duty while on active18 duty and is not eligible for retired pay; or

19 "(D) in the case of a member of a reserve
20 component, dies as a result of a line of duty
21 condition and is not eligible for retired pay.

"(d) DEPENDENTS.—A dependent of a member or
former member described in subsection (a) or (b) or of
an unremarried widow or widower described in subsection
(c) holding a valid Uniformed Services Identification and

Privilege Card shall be provided transportation on Depart ment of Defense aircraft, on a space-available basis, if the
 dependent is accompanying the member.

4 "(e) SCOPE.—Space-available travel required by this
5 section includes travel to and from locations within and
6 outside the continental United States.

7 "(f) DEFINITION OF DEPENDENT.—In this section,
8 the term 'dependent' has the meaning given that term in
9 section 1072 of this title.".

10 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec11 tions at the beginning of such chapter is amended
12 by inserting after the item relating to section 2641b
13 the following new item:

"2641c. Space-available travel on Department of Defense aircraft: reserve members, reserve members eligible for retired pay but for age; widows and widowers of retired members; and dependents.".

(b) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary of Defense shall
prescribe regulations to implement section 2641c of title
10, United States Code, as added by subsection (a).
