3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Empowering States"
- 5 Rights To Protect Consumers Act".

1 SEC. 2. LIMITS ON ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATES.

2 Chapter 2 of the Truth In Lending Act (15 U.S.C.
3 1631 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing:

5 "SEC. 141. LIMITS ON ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATES.

6 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the an-7 nual percentage rate applicable to any consumer credit 8 transaction (other than a residential mortgage trans-9 action), including any fees associated with such a trans-10 action, may not exceed the maximum rate permitted by 11 the laws of the State in which the consumer resides.".

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
