A BILL

To protect children from neglect and abuse on Federal property.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This Act may be cited as the "Federal Children's 4 Protection Act". SEC. 2. CHILD ABUSE REPORTING. 7 Section 226 of the Victims of Child Abuse Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 13031) is amended— 8 9 (1) in subsection (a)— (A) by striking "A person" and inserting 10

the following:

1	"(1) COVERED PROFESSIONAL.—Any person"
2	and
3	(B) by inserting at the end the following:
4	"(2) Other Persons.—In addition to those
5	persons in paragraph (1), any person who, while on
6	Federal land or in a federally operated (or con-
7	tracted) facility, learns of facts that give reason to
8	suspect that a child has suffered an incident of child
9	abuse, shall as soon as possible make a report of the
10	suspected abuse to the agency designated under sub-
11	section (d).";
12	(2) in subsection (b), by striking "subsection
13	(a)" and inserting "subsection (a)(1)"; and
14	(3) in subsection (e), by striking "mandated re-
15	porter groups" and inserting "covered professionals
16	described in subsection (b)".
