A BILL

To exclude ecosystem component stocks of fish from certain annual catch limits and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Fishery Science Im-
- 5 provement Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENT OF SCIENTIFIC DATA FOR ANNUAL
- 7 CATCH LIMITS.
- 8 (a) Scientific Data Required for Annual
- 9 Catch Limits.—Section 104(b) of the Magnuson-Stevens

Fishery Conservation and Management Reauthorization Act of 2006 (Public Law 109–479; 16 U.S.C. 1853 note) is amended— 3 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking "and" at the 4 5 end; (2) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-6 7 graph (5); and 8 (3) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-9 lowing: 10 "(3) shall not apply to a stock for which a stock 11 assessment has not been performed during the pre-12 vious 6-year period, if the Secretary has determined 13 pursuant to section 304(e) of the Magnuson-Stevens 14 Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16) 15 U.S.C. 1854(e)) that— "(A) the fishery is not subject to over-16 17 fishing of that stock; and 18 "(B) the stock is not overfished; "(4) shall not apply to an ecosystem component 19 20 stock; and". 21 (b) Ecosystem Component Stocks.—Section 104 22 of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Man-23 agement Reauthorization Act of 2006 (Public Law 109– 479; 120 Stat. 3584) is amended by adding at the end the following: 25

1	"(e) Ecosystem Component Stock.—
2	"(1) Definition.—In this section, the term
3	'ecosystem component stock' means a stock of fish
4	that the Secretary determines—
5	"(A) is a nontarget stock; and
6	"(B) is not subject to overfishing or over-
7	fished.
8	"(2) Prior determinations.—Ecosystem
9	component species as determined by the Secretary of
10	Commerce prior to the date of the enactment of the
11	Fishery Science Improvement Act of 2011, shall be
12	determined to be ecosystem component stocks as de-
13	fined by paragraph (1) after such date of enact-
14	ment.".
