To modify the criteria used by the Corps of Engineers to dredge small ports.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF CORPS OF ENGINEERS CRI-
- 4 TERIA TO DREDGE SMALL PORTS.
- 5 (a) Minimum Tonnage Requirement.—Notwith-
- 6 standing any other provision of law (including regula-
- 7 tions), effective beginning on the date of enactment of this
- 8 Act, the tonnage requirement with respect to the consider-
- 9 ation of dredging of small ports by the Corps of Engineers

- 1 shall be a minimum of 500,000 tons, as calculated in ac-
- 2 cordance with subsection (b).
- 3 (b) CALCULATION.—For purposes of subsection (a)
- 4 and any other activity of the Corps of Engineers carried
- 5 out on or after the date of enactment of this Act, tonnage
- 6 shall be calculated by each relevant port authority and
- 7 submitted to the Corps of Engineers.
