## A BILL

To provide criminal penalties for stalking.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Stalkers Act of 2011".

5 SEC. 2. CRIMINAL PROVISION RELATING TO STALKING, IN-

CLUDING CYBERSTALKING.

7 Section 2261A of title 18, United States Code, is8 amended to read as follows:
