#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Repealing the Job-
- 3 Killing Health Care Law Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE JOB-KILLING HEALTH CARE LAW
- 5 AND HEALTH CARE-RELATED PROVISIONS IN
- 6 THE HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION REC-
- 7 ONCILIATION ACT OF 2010.
- 8 (a) Job-Killing Health Care Law.—Effective as
- 9 of the enactment of Public Law 111–148, such Act is re-
- 10 pealed, and the provisions of law amended or repealed by
- 11 such Act are restored or revived as if such Act had not
- 12 been enacted.
- 13 (b) Health Care-Related Provisions in the
- 14 HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT OF
- 15 2010.—Effective as of the enactment of the Health Care
- 16 and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law
- 17 111–152), title I and subtitle B of title II of such Act
- 18 are repealed, and the provisions of law amended or re-
- 19 pealed by such title or subtitle, respectively, are restored
