- 3 SECTION 1. AMERICAN CENTRIFUGE PROJECT RESEARCH,

- 6 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Energy is au-
- 7 thorized to make \$150,000,000 available to carry out the
- 8 American centrifuge project research, development, and

- 1 demonstration program of the Department of Energy, to
- 2 remain available until expended, of which—
- 3 (1) \$44,000,000 shall be derived from proceeds
- 4 from the disposition of reenriched uranium from ex-
- 5 isting uranium owned by the Department of Energy;
- 6 and
- 7 (2) \$106,000,000 shall be derived from unobli-
- 8 gated balances of funds made available to carry out
- 9 other programs and activities of the Department.
- 10 (b) Reports.—The Secretary of Energy shall submit
- 11 to the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate, the
- 12 Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representa-
- 13 tives, the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources
- 14 of the Senate, and the Committee on Energy and Com-
- 15 merce of the House of Representatives quarterly reports
- 16 on the progress of the program described in subsection
