A BILL

To clarify the meaning of “produced” for purposes of limitations on the procurement by the Department of Defense of specialty metals within the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Steel
5 and Security Act of 2012”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL DEFINITION RELATING TO PRODUC-**
2 **TION OF SPECIALTY METALS WITHIN THE**
3 **UNITED STATES.**

4 Section 2533b(m) of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
6 graph:

7 “(11) The term ‘produced’, as used in sub-
8 sections (a) and (b), means melted, or processed in
9 a manner that results in physical or chemical prop-
10 erty changes that are the equivalent of melting. The
11 term does not include finishing processes such as
12 rolling, heat treatment, quenching, tempering, grind-
13 ing, or shaving.”.
