- 7 et seq.) is amended—

2	1821(t)(2)(A)), by inserting after clause (v) the fol-
3	lowing:
4	"(vi) The Bureau of Consumer Finan-
5	cial Protection."; and
6	(2) in section 18(x) (12 U.S.C. 1828(x))—
7	(A) by inserting "the Bureau of Consumer
8	Financial Protection," before "any Federal
9	banking agency" each place that term appears;
10	and
11	(B) by striking "such agency" each place
12	that term appears and inserting "such Bureau,
13	agency''.
