## A BILL

To remove restrictions from a parcel of land situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County, Virginia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS.
- 4 (a) Removal.—Not later than 90 days after the date
- 5 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
- 6 shall execute such instruments as may be necessary to re-
- 7 move all deed restrictions described in subsection (b) relat-
- 8 ing to the parcel of land described in subsection (c).
- 9 (b) DEED RESTRICTIONS.—The deed restrictions re-
- 10 ferred to in subsection (a) are those restrictions, including

- 1 easements, exceptions, reservations, terms, conditions, and
- 2 covenants described in Quitclaim Deed No. 17808A from
- 3 the United States to Accomack County, Virginia, executed
- 4 on December 20, 1976, and recorded among the real es-
- 5 tate records of Accomack County, Virginia, by the Clerk
- 6 of the Circuit Court, on pages 292 through 296 of Deed
- 7 Book 381.
- 8 (c) Description of Land.—The parcel of land re-
- 9 ferred to in subsection (a) consists of approximately 31.6
- 10 acres situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County,
- 11 Virginia, more particularly described in the metes and
- 12 bounds description recorded on page 292 of the quitclaim
- 13 deed described in subsection (b).
