A BILL

To preserve existing rights and responsibilities with respect to waters of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preserve the Waters
- 5 of the United States Act".

1 SEC. 2. IDENTIFICATION OF WATERS PROTECTED BY THE 2 CLEAN WATER ACT.

- 3 (a) In General.—Neither the Secretary of the Army
- 4 nor the Administrator of the Environmental Protection
- 5 Agency shall—
- 6 (1) finalize the proposed guidance described in
- 7 the notice of availability and request for comments
- 8 entitled "EPA and Army Corps of Engineers Guid-
- 9 ance Regarding Identification of Waters Protected

- 12 (2) use the guidance described in paragraph
- 13 (1), or any substantially similar guidance, as the

- 17 (b) Rules.—The use of the guidance described in
- 18 subsection (a)(1), or any substantially similar guidance,
- 19 as the basis for any rule shall be grounds for vacation
- 20 of the rule.
