3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Financial Disclosure

5 to Reduce Tax Haven Abuse Act of 2012".

6 SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF ACCOUNTS HELD IN TAX HAVENS.

7 Section 102(b)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act
8 of 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended—

(1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting ", with a 1 2 specific accounting of any financial interest held by the covered individual or their spouse in a country 3 4 that is considered as a tax haven as listed by the 5 Secretary of the Treasury and made available to the filer" after "calendar year"; and 6 7 (2) inserting at the end the following: "In compiling the list of tax havens under subpara-8 9 graph (A), the Secretary of the Treasury should consider for inclusion those jurisdictions which have 10 11 been previously and publicly identified by the Inter-12 nal Revenue Service as secrecy jurisdictions in Federal court proceedings.". 13

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
