A BILL

To permit voluntary economic activity.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Anti-Trust Freedom
- 5 Act of 2012".
- 6 SEC. 2. VOLUNTARY ECONOMIC COORDINATION BY INDI-
- 7 **VIDUALS.**
- 8 The Sherman Act (15 U.S.C. 1 et seq.), the Clayton
- 9 Act (15 U.S.C. 12 et seq.), and section 5 of the Federal
- 10 Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 45) shall not be con-
- 11 strued to prohibit, ban, or otherwise extend to any vol-
- 12 untary economic coordination, cooperation, agreement, or

- 1 other association, compact, contract, or covenant entered
- 2 into by or between any individual or group of individuals.
