3 **SECTION 1. YARN OF CARDED HAIR OF KASHMIR (CASH-**
4 **MERE) GOATS, OF YARN COUNT LESS THAN**
5 **19.35 METRIC, NOT PUT UP FOR RETAIL SALE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.85 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 yarn of carded hair of Kashmir (cashmere) goats, of yarn
9 count less than 19.35 metric, not put up for retail sale)

1 is amended by striking the date in the effective period col-
2 umn and inserting “12/31/2015”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
6 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
