- 3 SECTION 1. PREVENTING THE APPROVAL OF GENETI-
- 4 CALLY-ENGINEERED FISH.
- 5 Section 512(a) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
- 6 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 360b(a)) is amended by adding at
- 7 the end the following new paragraph:
- 8 "(7) Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 9 this section, a genetically-engineered fish shall be

- 1 deemed unsafe under this section, including for pur-
- 2 poses of section 402(a)(2)(C)(ii).".

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
