## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on woven fabrics containing 85 percent or more by weight of vicuna hair.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. WOVEN FABRICS CONTAINING 85 PERCENT OR**  
4       **MORE BY WEIGHT OF VICUNA HAIR.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.23 of the Har-  
6       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7       woven fabrics containing 85 percent or more by weight  
8       of vicuna hair) is amended by striking the date in the ef-  
9       fective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
