- To provide to the Administrator of the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service of the Department of Agriculture expedited authority to remove geese that threaten aircraft.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. CANADA GEESE REMOVAL.
 - 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—On a determination by the Fed-
 - 5 eral Aviation Administration that the population of Can-
 - 6 ada geese residing on land under the jurisdiction of the
 - 7 National Park Service that is located within 5 miles of
 - 8 any commercial airport poses a risk to flight safety, the

1	Secretary of Agriculture shall direct the Administrator of
2	the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, in con-
3	sultation with the Secretary of the Interior and the Ad-
4	ministrator of the Federal Aviation Administration—
5	(1) not later than 90 days after the date of the
6	determination, to publish a management plan that
7	provides for the removal, by not later than the first
8	subsequent molting period for Canada geese that oc-
9	curs after the date of publication, of all Canada
10	geese residing on the applicable land; and

- 11 (2) as soon as practicable after the date of pub-12 lication of the management plan under paragraph 13 (1), to commence removal of Canada geese from the 14 applicable land.
- 15 (b) JFK International Airport.—Not later than June 1, 2012, the Secretary of Agriculture, acting through 16 17 the Administrator of the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, shall— 18
- 19 (1) issue a record of decision for the document 20 entitled "Supplement to the Environmental Impact 21 Statement Bird Hazard Reduction Program: John 22 F. Kennedy International Airport"; and
- 23 (2) commence consultation with the Secretary 24 of the Interior to complete the collection and re-25 moval of Canada geese from the applicable National

- 1 Park Service land to ensure that the removal is com-
- pleted by not later than August 1, 2012.
