## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain porcelain lamp-holder housings.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN PORCELAIN LAMP-HOLDER 4 HOUSINGS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.30 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
lamp-holder housings of porcelain, containing sockets) is
amended by striking the date in the effective period column and inserting "12/31/2015".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 the date of the enactment of this Act.
