A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on o-Chloro-p-toluidine (3-chloro-4-methylaniline).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. O-CHLORO-P-TOLUIDINE (3-CHLORO-4-**
4 **METHYLANILINE).**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.16 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 o-Chloro-p-toluidine (3-chloro-4-methylaniline)) is amend-
8 ed by striking the date in the effective period column and
9 inserting “12/31/2015”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
