7	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
9	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
10	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Certain plastic laminate sheets consisting of layers of polyethylene film, polyethylene coextrusion copolymer of low density polyethylene and ethylene acrylic acid, and aluminum foil (provided for in subheading 3920.10.00)

11 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by 12 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or 13 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after 14 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
