3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF POLYETHYLENE GLYCOL, C16-**
4 **C18 FATTY ACIDS, AND C2-C6 ALIPHATIC HY-**
5 **DROCARBONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Mixtures of polyethylene glycol, (CAS No. 25322–68–3), C16-C18 fatty acids, and C2-C6 aliphatic hydrocarbons (provided for in subheading 3824.90.19)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
