A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Captan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CAPTAN.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	N-((Trichloromethyl)thio)-4-cyclohexene-1,2-dicarboximide (Captan) (CAS No. 133-06-2) and formulations thereof (provided for in subheadings 2930.90.4390 and 3808.92.1500)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
