To suspend temporarily the duty on certain non-toric shaped polarized materials of more than 80mm diameter.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN NON-TORIC SHAPED POLARIZED MA-**
4 **TERIALS OF MORE THAN 80MM DIAMETER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Polarized spectacle lenses, not cut to shape, and lens blanks, wafers, sheets, or plates, all the foregoing of polyvinyl alcohol (PVA) and polycarbonate, for the production of lenses for sunglasses, not toric-shaped, with an outer profile diameter of more than 80mm (provided for in subheadings 9001.20.00, 9001.50.00, or 9001.90.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
