8	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
9	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

	" 9902.01.00 Insulated food or beverage bags with outer surface of man made fiber, with removable inner liner of hard plastic, certified by the importer as containing over 40 percent by weight of recycled plastics, not to exceed 300 mm in length (provided for in subheading 4202.92.08)

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 13 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or 14 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after 15 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
