## A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary reduction of duty on black 820 inkjet printing ink.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BLACK 820 INKJET PRINTING INK.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.40 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6 black 820 inkjet printing ink) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “0.3%” in the column 1 general  
8 rate of duty column and inserting “Free”; and

9 (2) by striking the date in the effective period  
10 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
2 subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
