## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on flubendiamide.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FLUBENDIAMIDE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	3-Iodo-N-(2-methanesulfonyl- 1,1-dimethylethyl)-N'-(2- methyl-4-(1,2,2,2-tetrafluoro- 1- trifluoromethylethy- l)phenyl)phthalamide (Flubendiamide) (CAS No. 272451–65–7) (provided for in subheading 2930.90.10) ...	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
