To extend the temporary suspension of duty on mixtures of difenoconazole and mefenoxam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF DIFENOCONAZOLE AND**
4 **MEFENOXAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.53 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 mixtures of 1H-1,2,4-triazole, 1-((2- chlorophenoxy)-
8 phenyl)-4-methyl-1,3-dioxolan-2-yl)methyl)-
9 (Difenoconazole) (CAS No. 119446–68–3), (R,S)-2-((2,6-
10 dimethylphenyl)methoxyacetylamino) propionic acid,

1 methyl ester (Mefenoxam) (CAS Nos. 70630–17–0, and
2 69516–34–3) and application adjuvants) is amended by
3 striking the date in the effective period column and insert-
4 ing “12/31/2015”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
7 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
8 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
