A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on 1,3-benzenedicarbonitrile.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 1,3-BENZENEDICARBONITRILE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.12.06 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 1,3-benzenedicarbonitrile) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “3.4%” in the general rate of
8 duty column and inserting “Free”; and

9 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
10 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
