6	(a) In General.—Heading 9902.01.62 of the Har-
7	monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8	fluoropolymers containing 95 percent or more by weight
9	of the monomer units tetrafluoroethylene,
10	hexafluoropropylene, and vinylidene fluoride) is amended
11	by striking the date in the effective period column and
12	inserting "12/31/2015".
13	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
14	subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
15	withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
16	the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
