A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on macroporous ion-exchange resin comprising a copolymer of styrene crosslinked with divinylbenzene, thio functionalized.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MACROPOROUS ION-EXCHANGE RESIN COM-**
4 **PRISING A COPOLYMER OF STYRENE**
5 **CROSSLINKED WITH DIVINYLBENZENE, THIO**
6 **FUNCTIONALIZED.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.30 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
9 macroporous ion-exchange resin comprising a copolymer

1 of styrene crosslinked with divinylbenzene, thio
2 functionalized) is amended by striking the date in the ef-
3 fective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
6 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
7 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
