## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Strong Base Anionic Resin-Quaternary amine styrene divinylbenzene copolymer in the chloride form.

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. STRONG BASE ANIONIC RESIN-QUATERNARY**  
4                       **AMINE STYRENE DIVINYLBENZENE COPOLY-**  
5                       **MER IN THE CHLORIDE FORM.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9       new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Strong Base Anionic Resin- Quaternary amine styrene divinylbenzene copolymer in the chloride form (CAS No. 69011-15-0) (provided for in subheading 3914.00.60) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
