2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN SMOOTH NONWOVEN FIBERGLASS**
4 **SHEETS OF A TYPE PRIMARILY USED AS**
5 **ACOUSTICAL FACING FOR CEILING PANELS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.70.19 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 certain smooth nonwoven fiberglass sheets of a type pri-
9 marily used as acoustical facing for ceiling panels) is

1 amended by striking the date in the effective period col-
2 umn and inserting “12/31/2015”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
