11 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.02 of the Har-
12 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
13 aqueous emulsion of a modified aliphatic amine mixture
14 of: decanedioic acid, compounds with 1,3- benzene-
15 dimethanamine-bisphenol A-bisphenol A diglycidyl ether-
16 diethylenetriamine glycidyl phenyl ether reaction product-
17 epichlorohydrin formaldehyde- propylene oxide-
18 triethylenetetramine polymer) is amended by striking the
19 date in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/
20 2015”.

21 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
22 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
23 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
24 the date of the enactment of this Act.
