3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OF ALKENE POLYMERS WITH MA-**
4 **LEIC ANHYDRIDE, 2-(1-PIPERAZINYL)**
5 **ETHYLIMIDES, DIISONONYL PHTHALATE AND**
6 **BIS(1-METHYLETHYL)-NAPHTHALENE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.19 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 mixtures of alkene polymers with maleic anhydride, 2-(1-
2 piperazinyl) ethylimides, diisononyl phthalate and bis(1-
3 methylethyl)-naphthalene) is amended by striking the date
4 in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
7 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.
