A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on cellular plastic sheets for nano-retention filters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CELLULAR PLASTIC SHEETS FOR NANO-RETEN-**
4 **TION FILTERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Cellular plastic sheets of poly-tetrafluoroethylene with retention rating of 10-30 nanometers, for use in manufacturing filters of heading 8421 (provided for in subheading 3921.19.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
