A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on alginic acid, ammonium alginate, potassium alginate, calcium alginate, and magnesium alginate.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ALGINIC ACID, AMMONIUM ALIGNATE, POTAS-**
4 **SIUM ALGINATE, CALCIUM ALGINATE, AND**
5 **MAGNESIUM ALGINATE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.--.--	Alginic acid (CAS No. 9005-32-7), ammonium alginate (CAS No. 9005-34-9), potassium alginate (CAS No. 9005-36-1), calcium alginate (CAS No. 9005-35-0), and magnesium alginate (CAS No. 37251-44-8) (provided for in subheading 3913.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
