A BILL

For the relief of Guy Vang, Genevieve Chong Foung, Caroline Vang, and Meline "Melanie" Vang.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law, for the purposes of the Immigration and Na-
- 6 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Guy Vang, Gene-
- 7 vieve Chong Foung, Caroline Vang, and Meline "Melanie"
- 8 Vang shall be deemed to have been lawfully admitted to,
- 9 and remained in, the United States, and shall each be eli-
- 10 gible for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully

- 1 admitted for permanent residence under section 245 of the
- 2 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) upon
- 3 filing an application for such adjustment of status.
- 4 (b) Application and Payment of Fees.—Sub-
- 5 section (a) shall apply only if the application for adjust-
- 6 ment of status is filed with appropriate fees not later than
- 7 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 8 (c) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Numbers.—
- 9 Upon the granting of permanent resident status to Guy
- 10 Vang, Genevieve Chong Foung, Caroline Vang, and Meline
- 11 "Melanie" Vang, the Secretary of State shall instruct the
- 12 proper officer to reduce by 4, during the current or next
- 13 following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
- 14 that are made available to natives of the country of the
- 15 birth of Guy Vang, Genevieve Chong Foung, Caroline
- 16 Vang, and Meline "Melanie" Vang under section
- 17 202(a)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
- 18 U.S.C. 1152(a)(2)).
